Held in the picturesque sculpture garden at NGV International on St. Kilda Road, **Goodbye Summer** is the perfect opportunity for visitors to unroll the picnic rug and relax in the dappled shade while enjoying performances from Melbourne musical talents Geoffrey O'Connor, Teeth and Tongue, and The Orbweavers plus sets from RRR DJs.

This year's event coincides with the final day of the NGV's popular exhibition *The Mad Square: Modernity in German Art 1910–37* which explores the radical and provocative avant-garde art movements that emerged in Germany during one of the most important and chaotic periods of the twentieth century.

In the event of rain, performances will move into the Great Hall under the spectacular Leonard French stained glass ceiling.
