
JOHN OLSEN THE YOU BEAUT COUNTRY

John Olsen is one of Australia's greatest living artists. Born in Newcastle NSW in 1928, Olsen is well known for his energetic and distinctive painting style and in particular for his lyrical depiction of the landscape. He is a major figure in the story of Australian art and his unique and sensual pictorial language presents a very personal view of the world.

John Olsen: The You Beaut Country offers an unparalleled opportunity to examine Olsen's consummate place in Australian art history. His You beaut country series, which followed his return to Australia in 1960 after three years travelling in Europe, began what would be a lifelong interest in representing the landscape and Australian identity. These works are presented alongside his more recent paintings, prints and watercolours, including those inspired by the filling of Lake Eyre. The exhibition reveals an artist who at 88 years of age has lost none of his passion for his subject matter, nor his creative vitality and retains a unique ability to capture the spirit of the Australian landscape.

Nature, poetry, travel, and the Australian landscape have been important sources of ideas and inspiration for John Olsen's artmaking. Olsen regularly uses journaling to explore and develop these concepts. Olsen's journaling includes diverse sources of inspiration including lines of famous poetry, endless descriptions of research and ideas, sketches, photographs and creative prose. Through exploring the creative processes underlying John Olsen's practice, and the materials and techniques he uses in his artmaking, this presentation will assist students in their own creative thinking and folio development.
