

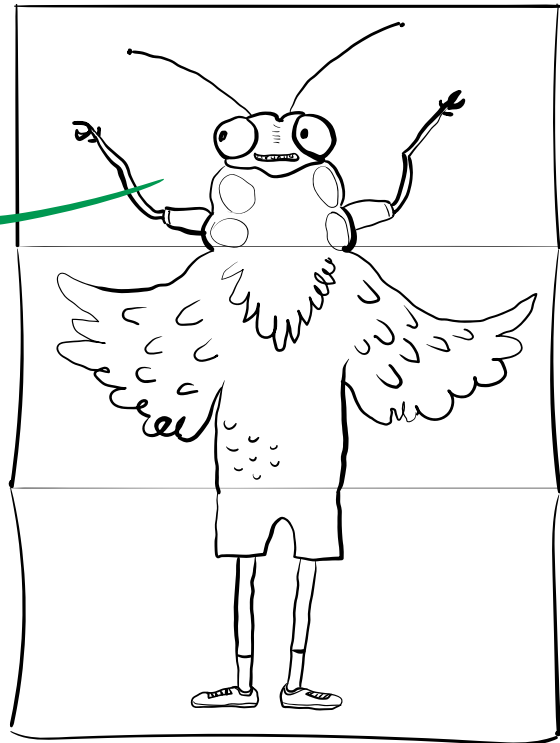
FUNNY THINGS!

This drawing game was invented by a group of artists called the Surrealists. Try drawing different heads, bodies and legs to create creatures never seen before!

You will need:

- * 2–3 players
- * A sheet of paper folded into 3 equal sections or a print out of the activity template
- * Coloured pencils or pens



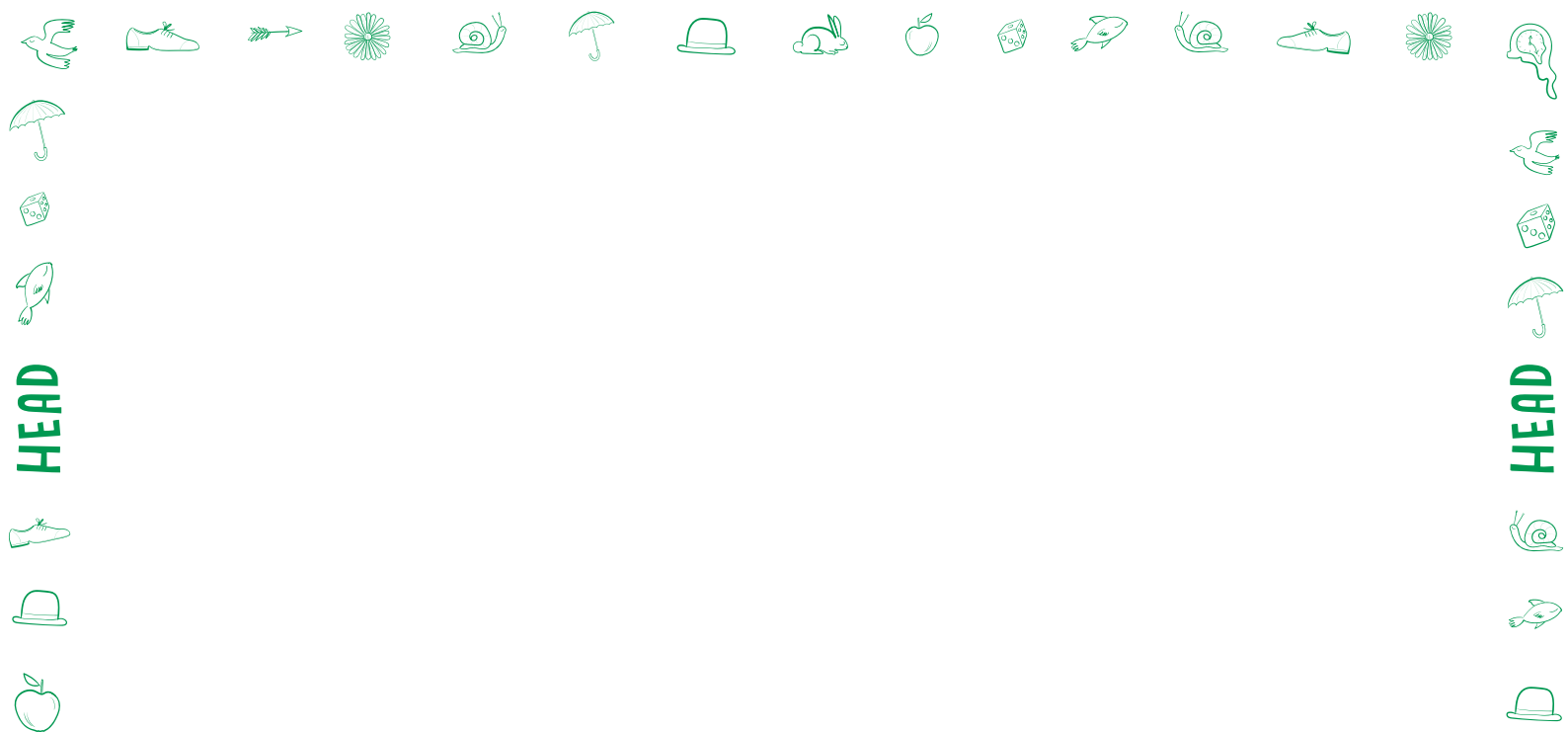
How to play

Take it in turns to draw different body parts.

- 1 The first player draws the head and neck of any creature at the top of the paper. Make sure no one can see your drawing.
- 2 Fold the paper to hide the drawing and pass it to the next player.
- 3 The second player secretly draws the body – any kind of body – in the middle section of the paper.
- 4 Fold the paper to hide the drawing and pass it to the next player.
- 5 The next player draws the legs. Remember, no peeking!

Now for the fun part – unfold the paper and see what you have made together!

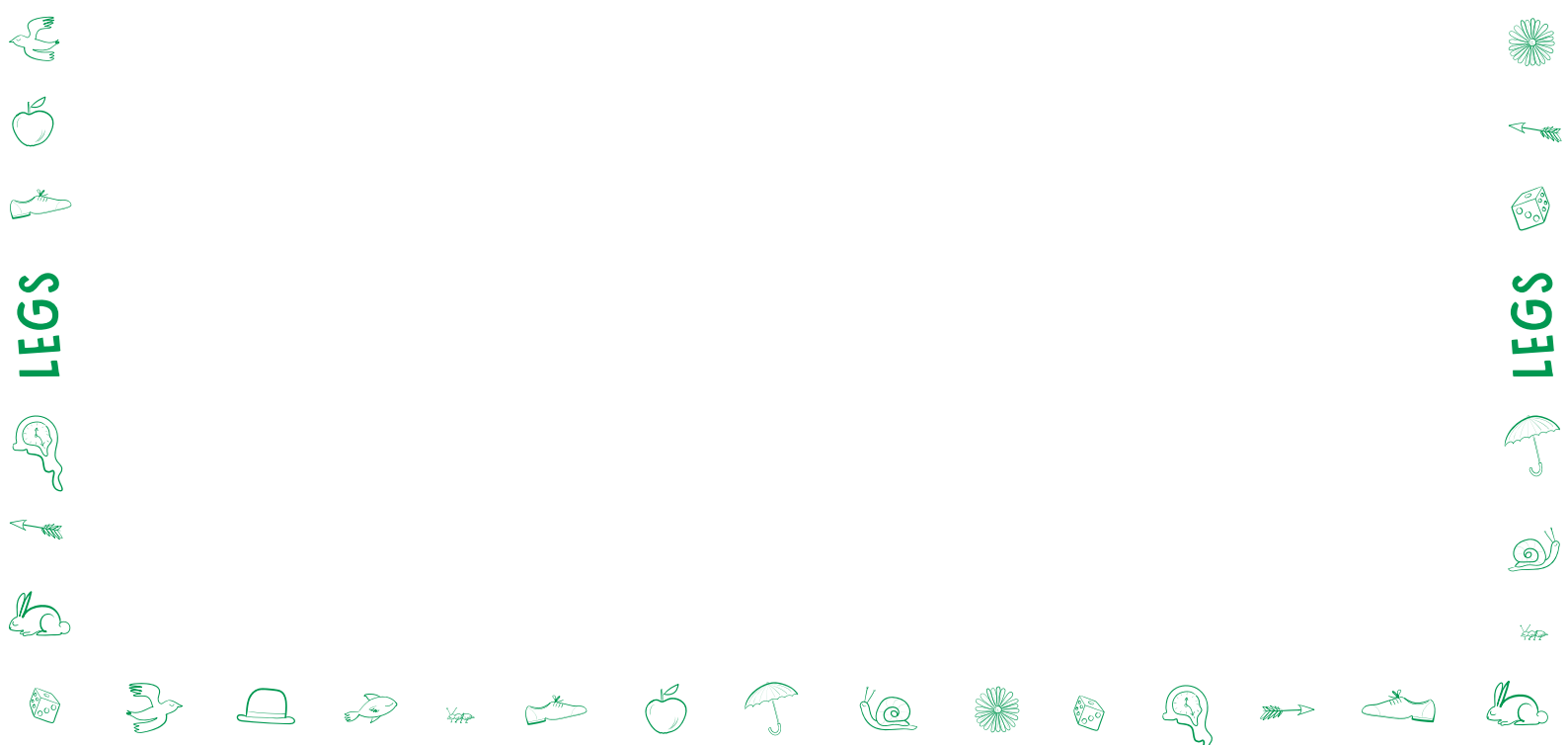
