First, draw a simple shape


Shaun Tan often starts with an oval but you can use any shape, like a triangle or a square.

For example, a head, arms, legs or a tail. Keep it simple.


Then, add the details

Give your character personality by adding things like eyes, hair or something to hold.




Creative characters can be inspired by many different things

Try combining an object with an animal to create an unexpected new character.


