Note to the reader

The list of works conforms to International and National Gallery of Victoria cataloguing standards and formats. Works are arranged in alphabetical order by primary artist and chronologically within each artist's listing. Artists' surnames are represented in upper case apart from Indigenous artists' names. All measurements are in centimetres to the first decimal point, height x width for two-dimensional objects, height x width x depth for three-dimensional objects. Measurements for watercolours, prints and drawings are represented by sheet size. Measurements for photographic works are represented by image size. Measurements in parentheses are approximate. Firm dates for works have been established from the artist's inscriptions. Dates supported by documentary evidence are in parentheses. The use of circa implies a two-year window either side of the central date. Numbers in brackets at the conclusion of the caption are accession numbers of the relevant lending institutions.
